Dear Parent(s) / Guardian(s):

As a parent/guardian of a child in a Dufferin-Peel Year 2 Kindergarten classroom, you may wish to consider the French Immersion (FI) program as a possibility for Grade 1 in September 2026. Virtual information sessions will be held in the upcoming weeks for all parents interested in the French Immersion program in the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB). French Immersion is a program in which 90% of the Grade 1 instruction is delivered in French.

DPCDSB offers the French Immersion program at the following schools. Please note that some schools only offer French Immersion until grade 4 and then the students are moved to another location for grades 5-8:

Please note that **transportation** is **NOT provided for students.** It is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s) to transport their children to and from the French Immersion centre for respective school hours.

This program offers an excellent opportunity for becoming functionally bilingual in later years. Students in the French Immersion program receive at least 4510 hours of instruction in French. By the end of Grade 8, the objectives are that students can:

- communicate effectively in French, by selecting the correct words and nuances, and adapting language in order to be understood;
- understand radio, television, newspapers, and books, with the occasional help of a translation service;
- demonstrate knowledge of cultures, societies, customs, and institutions of French-speaking communities and countries;
- function well in a French-speaking community.

There will be **French Immersion Parent Information Sessions** held online through the *Microsoft Teams* meeting platform. The session will provide more details about the French Immersion program and the application and registration process for Grade 1.

Application Process

The process for application, as well as the application deadline dates, will be shared at the French Immersion Parent/Guardian Information Sessions. Please note, in the case of an application by same-age/same-grade siblings, the parent/guardian shall submit *one application per sibling*.

Random Selection Process

Should the number of applications exceed the number of spaces available, a centralized, computer-generated random selection process will be held following the application deadline.
